Oedipus was the son of Laius, king of Thebes, and Jocasta. Laius had brought a curse upon his family and was informed by an oracle that he must perish at his son's hands and consequently ordered the destruction of the child. Oedipus was expelled, hung to a tree by a twig passed through his feet. (where his name, 'swollen-foot') but was rescued by a shepherd. In ignorance of his parentage, Oedipus later slew Laius his father, and having solved the riddle of the Sphinx, obtained Jocasta, his mother, for his wife, by whom he had two sons, Polynices and Eteocles, and two daughters, Ismene and Antigone. Having discovered the facts of his parentage, Oedipus, in horror at his crimes, put out his own eyes, while Jocasta hanged herself. He retired, led by his daughter Antigone, to Colonus in Athens, where he died. The story of Oedipus is the theme of tragedies by Sophocles. OUESTIONS:
