Faculty Research Seminar (FRS)

Second Faculty Research Seminar was held on 5th March 2016 at Faculty of Management Studies.

Dr. Vedvyas Dwivedi, Vice Provost, C U Shah University discussed the issue of *E – threat* on over life.
