Course Description: This course is designed to assist the PG students in preparation of their thesis or dissertation research proposal. The students will submit an acceptable draft of the Research Proposal and Term Paper related to the topic (5 credits) by the end of the course.

Prerequisite: The students are expected to be well-trained in using computer skills in preparing their proposal/dissertation thesis.

Objectives: Upon completion of the course the students should be able to:

1. Describe the research process.
2. Outline the elements of a thesis/ dissertation
3. Select a research topic of importance to the professions.
4. Effectively work with their academic advisor and graduate committee.
5. Develop and follow an appropriate timeline for completion of the thesis/dissertation.
6. Identify an appropriate theory base for their research.

7. Develop a conceptual model relevant to their research proposal.
8. Effectively use library resources in their research.
9. Follow AP/MLA style in preparing their research proposal.
10. Write the first three chapters of their thesis/ dissertation.
11. Receive IRC approval for their research project and
12. Identify and reduce/ eliminate barriers that may interfere with the development of a high quality thesis/ dissertation proposal.
